THE MASS

The Communion Rite – The Lord's Prayer After the Great Doxology and the people's strong 'Amen', the congregation stands for the Communion Rite which begins with our daring to pray to God in the words Jesus gave us, words which call to mind and proclaim that God is not a distant being separated from us but that he is close to us, he is the father of each one of us. The prayer is a very significant prayer which some see as a summary of the Gospel, but it also places before us what our attitude to God should be: we should be open to his will in our lives and to place his will and wish for us before our own will. The prayer also asks that God's kingdom be seen in this world and in our own time rather than being something confined to the next life, and that can only happen if we are open to God's will. The prayer reminds us to place our trust in God and in his providence and asks that we be protected from evil because, on our own, we will struggle to overcome the Tempter.

We reverently recite this prayer while standing and it is the custom in many places for people to hold their hands open in front of them with palms up showing their openness to God. The prayer was given by Jesus to the Apostles and takes us back to the Lord's own ministry and teaching.
